

Dear Siblings in Christ,

This past year I have tried to release a weekly newsletter in hopes to better communicate with you all that is happening at Tempe First. I have learned a few things since then.

ONE. Quality of information is better than quantity. It seems to me that our readership is low and I think that is because often, we are reproducing the same information week to week. I imagine people like the idea of having the newsletter in their inbox as a resource, but do not find it worthwhile to read through it each week. It would be better to share higher quality content that readers find beneficial, even if it is less frequent.

TWO. Weekly newsletters are costly. It takes a quarter of our staffed hours to put one together, even when much of it stays the same. Putting this new one together, for example, has taken 32 hours when accounting for the new design and layout. It would be better to make use of that time on diversifying our communication strategies.

THREE. Reading is a necessity, but listening is easier, especially when using small electronic devices. I hope you see where I'm going!

In lieu of sending out our annual Christmas offering envelopes with a pastoral letter, I share with you here the hope I have for the gifts we will prepare for the coming day of Christ's birth, when the light of our Savior shall illume our hearts anew.

Did you know 38% of U.S. pastors have thought of quitting full-time ministry last year? (Read here) The pandemic certainly contributed to this notion. 
