



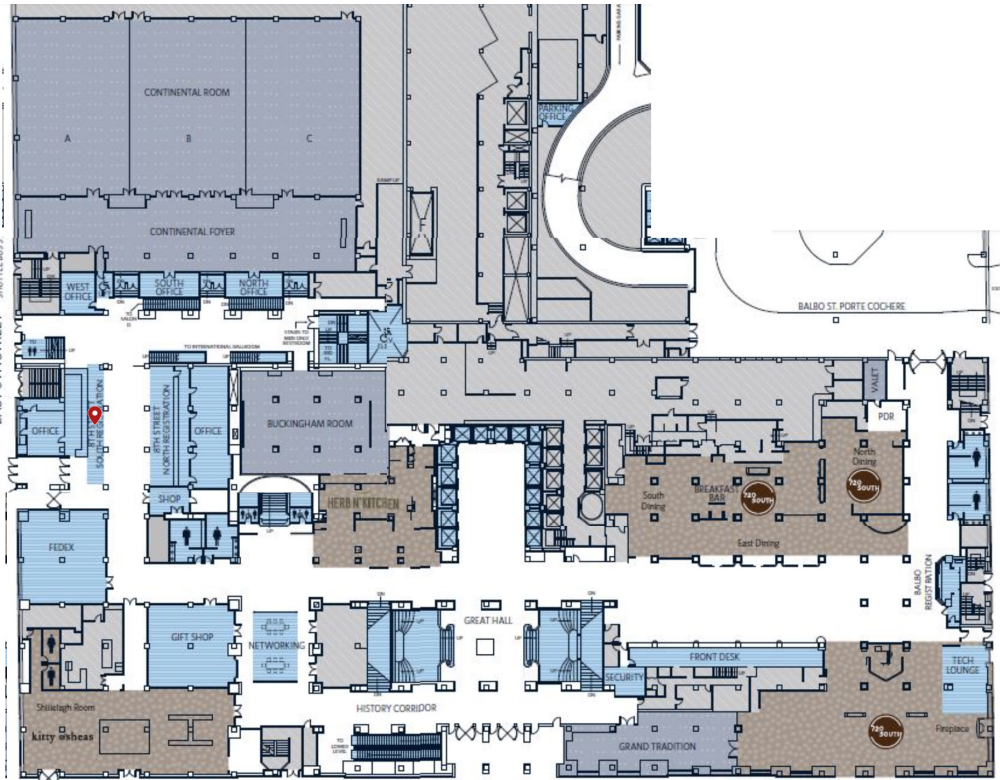

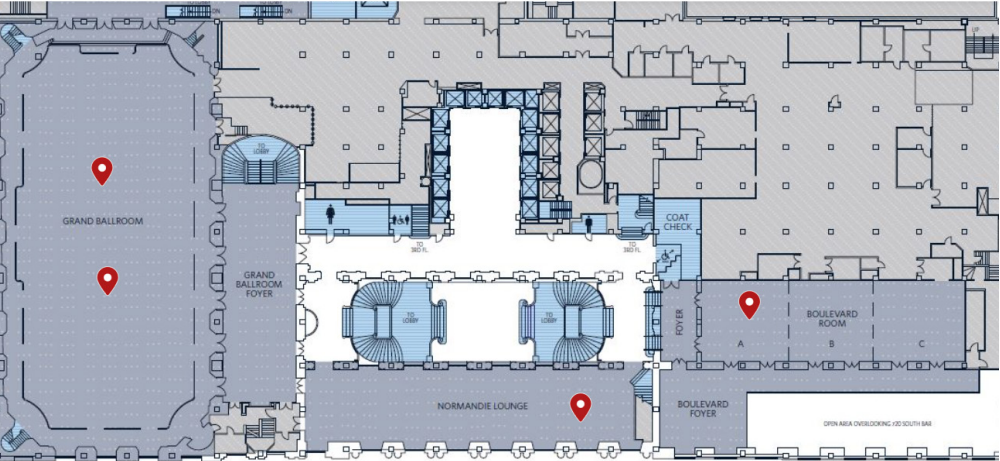


# HILTON HOTEL FLOOR MAP

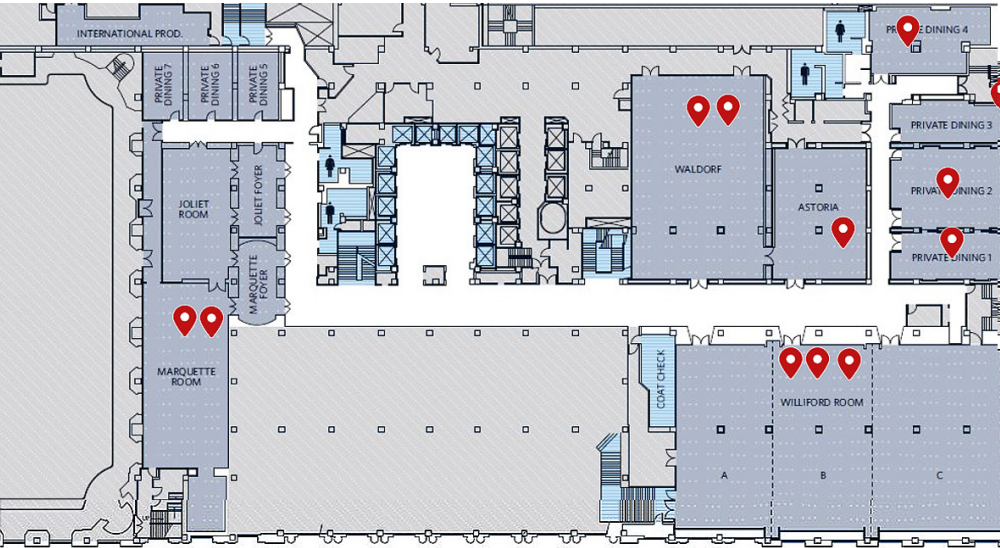
LOWER LEVEL

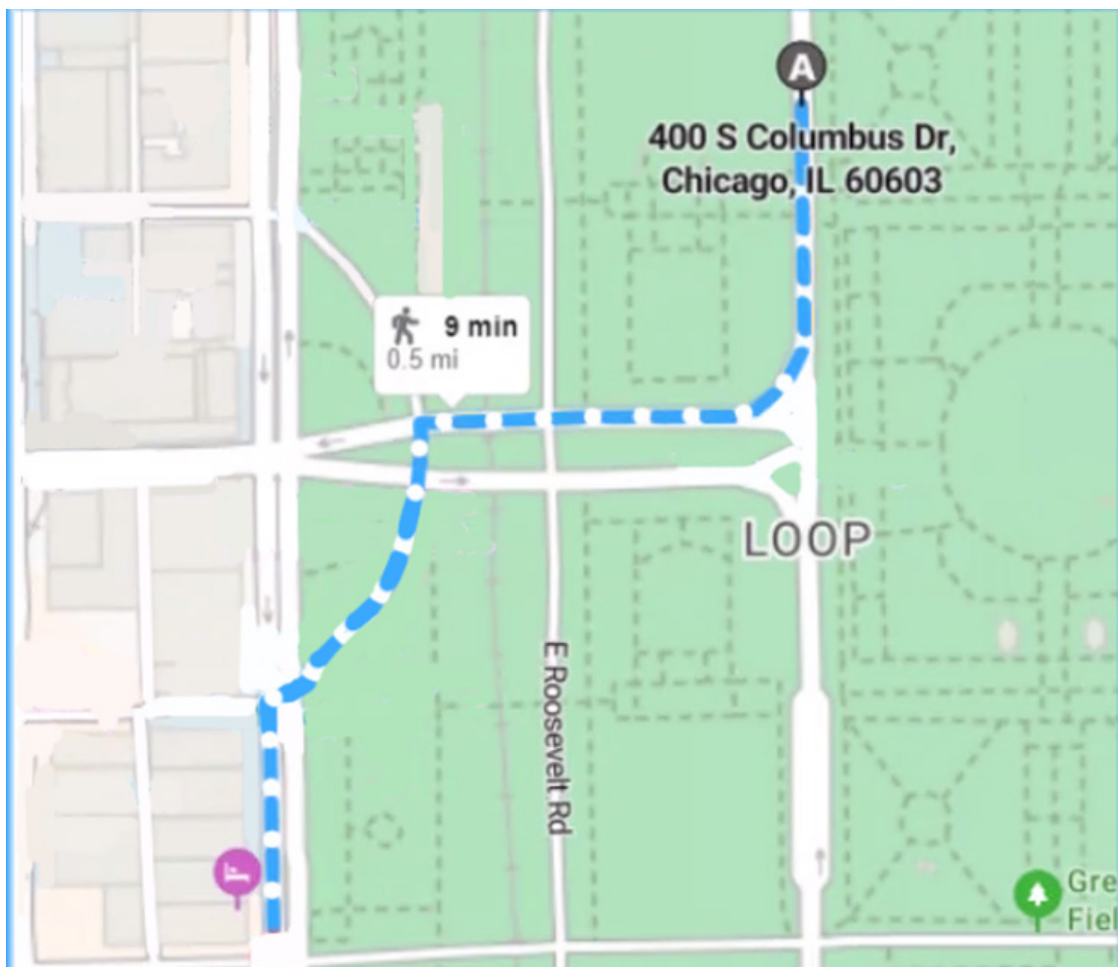
