

Per the October 20, 2022, Order of the Board of Public Health and Environment, the following is the Weekly Report for BPHE Docket Number 22-29:

a) the list of Residential Neighborhood Organizations (RNOs) receiving notifications;

Drilling started January 12th. Required notifications were sent previously. Copies of the December 30, 2022, letters were attached to a previous weekly report.

b) a copy of the notification sent to the RNOs;

See Item a). The 24-hr drilling phase started January 12th. Onsite non-drilling work during the week of the Jan 9 through Jan 15 also included setup of the rig and equipment, and start-up and conditioning of the drilling mud system. All non-drilling work was done during daytime hours. The upcoming week (Jan 16 through Jan 22) includes continuation of the drilling phase. The 24-hour drilling phase should end by February 1st. Copies of the December 30, 2022, RNO letters were attached to a previous weekly report.

c) a list of the households eligible for hotel vouchers;
