

Per the October 20, 2022, Order of the Board of Public Health and Environment, the following is the Weekly Report for BPHE Docket Number 22-29:

a) the list of Residential Neighborhood Organizations (RNOs) receiving notifications;

Required notifications were sent December 30, 2022. Drilling started January 12, 2023. A project update was sent February 17, 2023. Copies of all RNO letters were attached to previous weekly reports.

b) a copy of the notification sent to the RNOs;

See Item a). Copies of all RNO letters were attached to previous weekly reports. The 24-hr drilling phase started January 12th, ended January 24th, and is now complete. As of Thursday, February 23rd, the well testing is now complete. The past week (Feb 27 through Feb 28 - end date of the variance request) did not include any well drilling and testing activities since that work is now complete.

c) a list of the households eligible for hotel vouchers;

None for the period of Feb 27 through Feb 28. The 24-hr drilling phase started January 12th, ended January 24th, and is now completed. As of Thursday, February 23rd, the well testing is now complete. The variance request expired February 28th.

d) a list of the eligible households that used hotel vouchers;
