Election Sign Reminders

As we are all aware we are in the heart of a presidential election for our country, and we just wanted to remind everyone of the Rules in place for election signs in Madison Place.

As per the resolution passed by your Board in 2019:

"Signs for political candidates and/or flags can be displayed in windows. However, only one sign and/or flag can be displayed in one interior window, unless your home fronts two streets, then one sign may be displayed on each street side. Signs for political candidates and/or flags displayed in windows are permitted to be displayed six months prior to an election and must be removed two weeks after
