AMENDMENTS & ADDITION TO ORGINAL BY- LAWS ADOPTED AUGUST 23, 1976

Due to the limited space, increasing number of graves and the problems encountered in the upkeep of the Cemetery, the following regulations had to be adopted:

- 1. All graves plots will be designated in a certain section of the Cemetery. Each person should be made aware of where their plot is located. Any space taken or marked off in any way that has not been recorded by a Committee Member will not be recognized by the Cemetery Association.
- 2. Due to incorrectly marked gravesites, in the future at the death of a member of your Family, a Committee Member must be present when the marker is set for the grave.
- 3. There will be no small fences, large stones or rocks, or any objects which will be an obstruction in the upkeep of the Cemetery. Grave plots can be marked by markers that are buried in the ground that lawn mover can go over. Graves will be leveled off so that the Cemetery can be cleaned and mowed. Those who do not want their graves leveled will be responsible for keep them mounded.
- 4. The Board of Directors will serve for a term of three (3) years. Beginning May 7, 1983 election will be held for the 3 year term of service.
