## General terms

When commissioning me, you automatically agree to these terms.

- Commission status: check on top of the commission page of <a href="https://lysified.com">https://lysified.com</a>
- My commission projects lie on the base of mutual respect and kindness. I respect you and will always be kind to you, but I'd like to ask you to do the same with me. I retain my right to decline or cancel (and refund) commissions where this is violated as I regard my (and your) mental health to be a very important factor. I'd not like either of us to be stressed. I live my life in the UTC+1 timezone, so please keep that in mind. (If I don't respond fast, I might be sleeping:))
- At this point I only take Paypal payments.
- Be sure to write clearly and provide references! Please do refer to one of the styles listed on my website <a href="https://lysified.com">https://lysified.com</a> and tell me which of the styles you have in mind. At the moment I only do single subject drawings, but I might do an exception if you have a reference image you can show and I see that I can deliver the same quality. Additional subject comes with 80% of the price. If you want an unusual element on it, please let me know.

### Unusual element can be:

Something that is highly detailed and not in the original description (A fully detailed plant, house, etc)

An interesting way of drawing (florals blooming from the chest for example)

- I will send you some WIPs to keep in touch if asked or if I have any questions to ask about the commission. Sketches can be altered in a big way (have to redraw big parts of the work) twice before I go into coloring. After that, before full rendering is finished you'll have one free chance to alter the artwork for free.
- I am happy to make small changes as requested until I start the coloring phase. However, big changes to the art once it is finished or in the final stages will come with extra charge of 20\$/time I have to redraw parts of the artwork.
- As the artist I hold all of the right to the art that is produced. I have the right to post the artwork wherever I would like and promote it at any place of platform, unless you specifically ask me not to. Keep in mind, that this comes with additional fee of 10\$.
- I have the right to cancel and refund the money for your commission at any time. Once I've already begun working on the art You may not demand refunds. If the money has not been sent yet then the commissioner can cancel the commission at any time.

- Purchase of commercial rights will always come with a fee! As an approximate, count at least 2.5 times more to pay as I listed on my website.
- Deadlines: if your art needs to be done extra fast, I can do that.
  Fees that apply:

Within 2 days 50% more than the listing price Within 7 days 30% more than the listing price

- YOU CANT: Take credit for the creation of the artwork of design that I have created, retrace, redraw my artwork, use in commercial projects without commercial license, this includes digital, physical products, marketing, NFTS, Al art, branding, remove any watermarks/signatures, or alter the artwork without asking me prior.
- YOU CAN: Use the commission for personal use, post it anywhere you would like with credit, set it as your profile picture.

# How the work is completed

- 1. You contact me via e-mail or Instagram DM to talk to our future project together. Provide: what style exactly you are looking for from my website price list. Keep in mind to let me know if you are okay with my 14 day turn around time or you need it faster. You can find this on <a href="https://lysified.com">https://lysified.com</a> If you don't provide this info, no worries, I will direct you to the place where you can pick what you'd like!
- 2. Provide what you'll use my artwork for. It is always requested to provide what the purpose of the commission is.

#### Personal use:

You'd like to use the art for a gift for a friend, a profile picture, post it on your own social media.

#### Commercial use:

You'll benefit from my artwork in a monetary way. Examples of commercial use include print on demand, selling it to third party, using it as branding for your own brand.

**3.** I'll tell you what you can expect to pay. At this point you have to agree or tell me if it's not suitable for you as per agreement on being respectful about each others' time.

## 4. Payment:

# I take 50% down payment up front through Paypal only.

This secures your spot in my commission queue and let's you know that I am and will work on your project for sure. Be mindful that from this point on, you can not request a refund, however I hold the right to cancel this project if the terms of mutual respect are not met or I suspect any of my terms to be violated.

#### 5. I start working on your project:)

I'll ask questions, so you might as well think about it right now, before commissioning me: What are the main colors you are looking for?

Would you like any small elements to be added? (gouache floral lineart, clouds, stars)

I'll provide you with 3 color palettes to choose from depending on what color you asked earlier and a sample of the small elements for your approval.

### 6. Presentation – I'll present you the sketch of the artwork

This is the point where you can request small adjustments in composition, elements to be added or removed, and one big change (for example hair shape redraw).

Once you approved of my ideaboard, I'll move into making the lineart.

### 7. Going into rendering (coloring and shading)

You'll be asked to pay the second half of the payment at this point. You have 24h to do so before I cancel this project. (Let me know if there are any issues, if there is anything, we can extend it for another 24h)

## 7. Work in progress updates

As stated in the general terms, you can check in on me to see how your art is progressing and you can ask for a minor detail to be changed, if you like, once. I'll also provide you on my own with updates when I work on your project, so you know how things are going.

# 8. Reaching full completion

As I reach full completion, you'll be hopefully more and more excited to see the full art! And I'll be more and more excited to know if you like it or not. :)

## 9. Delivery

I deliver your artwork in high resolution for you to enjoy (4000\*5000 px in 300 dpi) in e-mail to the e-mail address you provide. You can ask me to upload it to inprnt also so you can order your own art gallery quality print of it as well. (this is a print on demand site, and for personal commissions the art only stays up until you ordered it, unless I specifically state that I want to sell prints of it)
