Get ready for an exclusive behind-the-scenes look at three of Victoria's most important racing and training centres as part of the 2025 TAB ARMA Conference Racecourse Tour. Flemington Racecourse

We begin the day at the home of Australian racing, Flemington. World-renowned as the host of the Melbourne Cup, Flemington is a historic and prestigious venue with world-class turf and track management.
