



Terms & Conditions

For Horses & Livestock;

Shipper &/or Owner, of horse(s) &/or Livestock, understands that all due diligence will be taken to provide for the safety of their horse(s)&/or Livestock. The owner authorizes veterinarian care at owner's expense should it become necessary. 4M Livestock will make every effort to notify owner before any such services shall be rendered. 4M Livestock is not liable for the death of owner's horse(s) &/or Livestock, or any injuries sustained while in transit. 4M Livestock strongly recommends that the owner of horse(s) &/or Livestock, carry full liability and major medical/mortality insurance on any horse(s) &/or livestock being transported. If the OWNER does not carry insurance, the owner of horse(s) &/or livestock, assumes full responsibilities for the loss of the horse(s) &/or Livestock should any loss (death or injury) occur. If a horse(s) &/or Livestock is a danger to transport to the carrier and/or to other horses &/or livestock on the trailer. The Carrier has the right to refuse transport of the horse &/or Livestock without refund of deposit.

All Horse(s) being transported across state lines require the following;

- 1) A negative Coggins within the prior 12 months
- 2) A health certificate within the prior 30 days of transport.

All Livestock being transported across state lines require the following

- 1) A health certificate within the prior 30 days of transport.
- 2) Cattle require a brand inspection

Carrier &/or Owner, agrees that the deposit invoice payment, and any additional payments made, is non-refundable in the event the transport is canceled by the Shipper(Customer) for any reason. In the event the transport is canceled by the Carrier(4M Livestock). The deposit invoice and any additional payments will be refunded in full.

In the event the described item/s on the bill of lading is inside the trailer, or in the care and control of the Carrier, and transport is suddenly canceled by Shipper &/or Owner, or forced to return the described item on the bill of lading by acts other than that of the Carrier. The Shipper &/or Owner, will pay the Carrier \$300 or \$3.00 per scheduled loaded mile, whichever is greater. In addition to any previously paid funds.

By accepting the estimate or paying for any invoice for the described property on the bill of lading. You are agreeing to these Service Provider's Terms and Conditions
