## UMC General Conference Update

Dear Members and Friends of ENUMC:

Having just returned from the UMC General Conference, February 23-26, 2019, I am still raw with and from the emotions that were expressed over this four-day event.

As you know, the conference was convened to vote on the issue of removing the restrictions on same sex marriage and the ordination of LGBTQ persons within the Church.

It was a heart-wrenching experience. Representatives for both sides of the argument poured their hearts out in support of their beliefs. As we listened, debated, searched our hearts, and prayed, our brokenness and pain were exposed.

It is evident that the United Methodist Church is still clearly a denomination that is loved and faithfully served by millions.

The concluding vote was made on Tuesday, February 26th. The Body voted for the adoption of the "Traditional Plan" which maintains the current language in the Book of Discipline. While this decision is consistent with the United Methodist Church's historic stance on human sexuality, it in no way changes our belief in the fundamental tenets of Christian love and compassion. We are all created in the image of Christ and have the same sacred worth.







We know that many of our progressive brothers and sisters in the faith are hurting and we see you. We love you.

In the days, weeks, and months ahead, we will continue to welcome to East Naples UMC all people. We will continue to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with all people. And, we will continue on our mission of "connecting Christ to people through love" here in Naples, Florida and beyond.

Thank you so much for the prayers before and during the conference—they were truly felt and appreciated. Let us, however, persist in prayer. Pray for our own church, its members, leadership, staff, and the lives of those in our community that we hope to connect to Christ. Pray for unity in the Body of Christ, for peace, wisdom, forgiveness, love, and understanding.

Finally, please know that I am available to answer any questions you may have or if you just need clarity on what the decision means for the denomination. In the meantime, may the peace of Christ be yours now, today, and always.

## Congregational Care



**Mission** - Following Jesus by reducing hunger and improving lives worldwide through partnerships that equip people with agricultural resources and skills.

**ECHO's** primary functions are providing agricultural information to overseas workers, distributing seeds for promising food plants, and offering training opportunities at the Florida farm. ECHO has been working to spread knowledge of hunger solutions for over 35 years. ECHO co-founder, Dr. Martin Price, believes God was led him to find a way to use science to help the very poor and to be involved with the "great commission."

There are three ways we can help: Pray that ECHO can continue their work to reduce hunger in our world; support ECHO financially; and spread the word about ECHO's work to those you know.
