"Dan Jackson has a history of leadership in one of our denomination's most fruitful churches, New Covenant UMC in the Villages, and as our Director of New Church Development for over five years," Bishop Carter said. "He has also been a key participant in the Visions Training for Multicultural Leadership and has been instrumental in implementing our vision with the Fresh Expressions movement. Dan has served on the appointive cabinet for the past two years and has a high trust level with other superintendents and with key leaders across our conference."

In his work as a conference leader, Dan has been instrumental in developing and managing the Cabinet Development Fund, which has helped reduce apportionments and strategically grow vitality in some of our strongest and most diverse churches. Additionally, Dan founded the Generative Church Leader Academy, which has trained 93 clergy to grow in their leadership.

While serving at New Covenant, Jackson was part of developing a transitional housing ministry, a jail ministry, programs in leadership and spiritual development, fundraising for a \$5.5 million facility expansion and planning for a second campus.
