A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

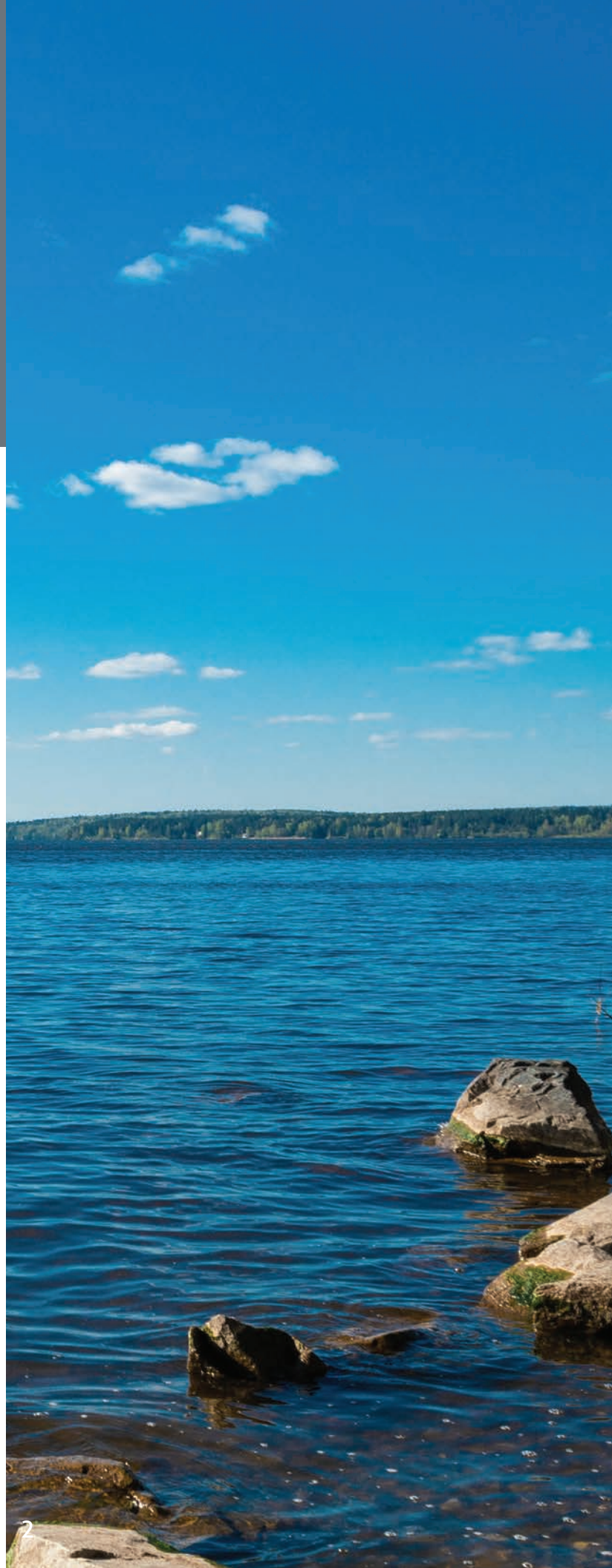

IMPROVEMENTS TO GREEN LAKES EMERGENCY SERVICES:

With the formation of Green Lake Twp. Emergency Services in January 2017, one of the strategic operational goals was to improve our Township's fire protection Public Protection Classification (PPC) rating through ISO, the Insurance Services Office. According to the Insurance Services Office, "The ISO Public Protection Classification (PPC™) is an evaluation program that provides information on the quality of public fire protection in nearly 50,000 fire protection areas across the United States. In April 2017, Green Lake Twp. Fire command staff underwent a formal evaluation of our fire suppression capabilities, staffing, equipment, water supply, training, 911 communications, and geographic response area. **After our April evaluation, ISO issued Green Lake Township an improved ISO rating of 4/5/LOW that became effective November 01, 2018. Improved rating from a "8" to a "4" for a hydrant area. Improved rating from a "8" to a "5" for property within five (5) road miles of our fire station.**

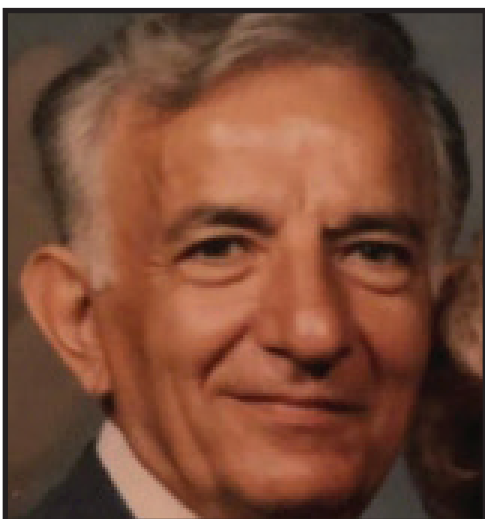
