Oversight is provided by a board of trustees elected by the membership. Activities include lectures/presentations, tours and other educational programs.

WHAT'S AN ESQUATAK?

Esquatak is an Indian name meaning "the fireplace of the nation," so called because the council-seat of the famed Mohican Indians was located in the Town of Schodack. Beside Esquatak, the Indians had villages called Potkoke, Wyomenock and others.
