



## ALLERGY AWARENESS BY ALLERGEN – 4 of 5 Pages

**SOY** - Assume that in addition to those flavors having wheat, rye, or barley, many other flavors may also have Soy. Soy is used as an emulsifier and will appear often on a label as soy or an ingredient called Soy Lecithin, which basically helps the fat molecules to stay small and the fat and water to work together. (Even in dry goods!) This acts similarly to the lecithin in eggs which enhances creaminess and mixing while working on the relationship between fat and water. **Many candies have Soy, whether in the ice cream or as a topping.**

**SOY LECITHIN** - is often used as an emulsifier in many baked goods and/or candy products. Therefore, assume baked goods containing wheat, rye, or barley and candy products have soy lecithin.
