



## The Caucus Annual Vote – November 2022 - Until Now

### November 2022 - Fall Annual Vote

The Caucus' candidate for Mayor failed to receive the necessary majority vote from the General Caucus Membership (all Lake Forest residents registered to vote) to be slated as Mayor. The Caucus Committee convened, claimed their 60+ year old bylaw regarding the vote was non-binding, and did not honor it.



### April 2023 - Spring Annual Vote

The Caucus Committee Leadership changed its decades old ballot of "Yes" or "No" for each individual candidate to "Yes" only for the entire slate.

### November 2023 - Fall Annual Vote

The Caucus Leadership proposed an amendment to its bylaws, the Caucus Preservation Act (CPA). If passed, the CPA would have removed our voting rights completely. We overwhelmingly defeated it.



### April 2024 – Upcoming Spring Annual Vote

Caucus Leadership again presents entire slate ballot. Option this year to vote "NO." Also:

- No oversight to ballot counting
- Only one hour for community to cast their vote
- No numbering of ballots for accountability
- Several officers slated are those who dishonored the 2022 vote and then supported the CPA
