## **Vote in New Member**

Natasha made motion, Shelley seconded, to vote in new member Phillipe Ledoux . All Ayes. Motion carried.

#### **Treasurer Update**

Marlys D. reported that the current balance in the checkbook was \$15,881. Recent transactions were a reimbursement of \$1,000 for coffee pots, check received for \$1,500 from the triathlon, payment to Copy Pro for \$145, and a check was received for \$460 that is thought to be from CenterPointe (Natasha's employer). Year to date raised for Family Pathways was \$2,213 in cash, 2,535 pounds of food, and an estimated \$300 from the mitten tree. The annual storage fee will be due early in 2026.

## Adopt a Senior Update

Marlys D. reported that the current balance in the check was \$4,372. Recent transactions included \$120 for printing. Folders are complete but need more for upcoming Expo on October 17. The next meeting AaS meeting will be on Monday, October 13 at 6 p.m. There was a need for more GNC members to volunteer; three people needed to be matched up. There was a suggestion to post October's committee meeting on the GNC GroupMe and to focus the next GNC meeting icebreaker on Aas. Marlys had concerns on the committee becoming too big since the meeting took place at her home, so an alternate space may be needed. Natasha will post Aas activities in the newsletter. Marlys will include Natasha when sending out Aas meeting notes.

### **Membership Update**

There was a discussion on a fully online application process rather than attachment of applications. Natasha will explore options with technology.
