#### Approve Minutes for the April 10, 2025, Club Meeting

### **Treasurer Update**

- GNC Account. Marlys reported there was currently \$7,129 in the checkbook. Recent expenditures equaled \$2,800, which included \$645 spent on food from the food drives, \$200 for apparel, \$200 for Harmony in the Park sponsorship, \$100 for the coffee pot steam initiative that will go to Lindstrom Ambassadors for scholarships, \$1,000 was spent to purchase more coffee pots to sell at the steam event, \$200 for website renewal fee, and \$121 for Adopt a Highway cleanup event. The Chamber will be giving the Club \$3,500 it earned from Celebration of the Lakes raffle sales.
- AaS Account Marlys reported there was \$4,513 in the Adopt a Senior checkbook. There had been no recent changes to the account. There was a need to spend money on more flyers.

<u>Membership Committee Update</u> The committee is in transition with Rochell being out due to medical issues. Help is needed to welcome new members and provide them with information on the Club and Club events. Encourage people to join the club. Trying to get motivation and support. Membership has hit 100 since the last meeting.

- Coffee Pot Steam Event June 21, 2025. Members have signed up to help in the booth, but there may be a
  need for one more person. There was also a need for support at the dunk tank. Two to three people are
  needed for the 3-6 p.m. shift. The business group is looking for volunteers to be dunked.
- Zion Community Meal June 23, 2025. There are 18 members who signed up for the community meal.
   Natasha will be sending out a reminder email.
- Karl Oskar Parade July 12, 2025. There was a discussion on what to hand out at the parade. It was decided to hand out candy and to spend \$750 for both the Karl Oskar Parade and the Ki Chi Parade. There needed to be a starting place for the float, and it was decided to ask Maggie if we could use her place for staging, as in the past. Marlys will be signing up the Club for both parades.
- Harmony in the Park Non-Profit Night July 16, 2025. The GNC name is on the banner and flyer. Craig and
  Patty offered to set up the canopy. Only a few members are needed to tend the booth, and volunteer(s) are
  needed to go on stage and promote the Club.
- Chisago Lakes Triathlon July 26-27, 2025. The GNC is the host for the Water Route. Two more volunteers are still needed for the Kid's Swim, which is a half-hour event with three age categories. Eight more Kayakers are needed for the Water Route and three more pontoons are needed. Scott has two extra kayaks and Trena has four. Volunteer signup is done online and your shirt order taken. There was discussion on a beer tent fundraiser. Chris and Marlys had met with the Uncommon Loon and Triathlon organizers, who do not want to run it. There was discussion on volunteers being needed and whether it would be worth it. This item was tabled.

Dana talked about the "play books" she was putting together that would have all the information for someone to take charge of a specific event. She will be creating one for all the annual GNC events and she encouraged people to volunteer for the Event Committee and bring new ideas.

### **Chisago Lakes Area Community Foundation Big Idea Grant Update**

Chris D. reported that the Chisago Lakes Community Foundation has another big idea grant. Grant submissions are being accepted from August 1 through September 14. The top award is up to \$12,000. They are looking for events that are local and community based. They are also giving away smaller grants. Marlys talked about work that was done in collaboration with the Chisago Lakes Achievement Center for a state grant for senior programing, but the time line for submission could not be met.
