The Economy

- Lower prescription drug costs, crack down on price gouging & junk fees, price controls in housing.
- R "America First": Bring back jobs, unleash American energy, restore economic growth, secure the borders, cut taxes.

First Amendment & Religious Liberty

- D Enforce separation of church & state. Honor government regulations & civil rights above religious freedom.
- Protect the right of free speech & free worship and the ability to act according to your deeply held beliefs.

Sanctity of Human Life

- D Supports national legislation to allow abortion through birth, to be funded by taxpayers.
- R No national legislation or taxpayer funding. Stands for families/life, supports mothers & advanced prenatal care.

National Security & The Border

- Hire more border officials, taxpayer funding of cities/states to shelter "immigrants". (no mention of border wall)
- R Halt release of illegal aliens into the U.S., complete the border wall, end taxpayer funded benefits for illegals.

Education Choice

- Oppose funding for home/private schools. Expand government control of education and schooling.
- Money follows the child. Universal school choice. Ensure parental control within the school system.

LGBTO & Women's Sports

- Expand Title IX protections. Allow access to women's spaces and enforce recognition of gender preference.
- R Keep men out of women's sports and locker rooms. Stop taxpayer funding of sex change operations, protect minors.

Definition of Marriage & Role of the Family

- Will pass the "Equality Act" to codify protections for LGBTQI+ in employment, adoption & foster care systems.
- R Values the sanctity of marriage & families, blessings of children & will end policies that punish families.


