

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD



Children's Liturgy of the Word will begin on Sunday, September 30th at the 11am Mass. Each week, children from ages 4-8 are encouraged to join us to hear the

scripture in terms that they can understand. Children will be led to the Father Prus Hall after the opening blessing and introduced to the readings and gospel using projects and creativity while helping them learn about the Catholic faith. It's a great introduction to the message of the mass for our youngest disciples! "Let the children come to me, for the kingdom of Heaven belongs to them." - Matthew 19:14 AT THIS TIME WE ARE IN NEED OF ADULTS TO LEAD THIS WONDERFUL GROUP. The commitment is only once a month and could be less if more join us to lead. Please pray on it and contact me if you'd like to join us!

IMPORTANT UPDATES FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF DETROIT

We are continuing the efforts begun in June of 2023, when the Archdiocese of Detroit implemented new changes to the Office for Child and Youth Protection for our Safe Environment compliance. WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

If you are an adult volunteer at St. Thomas the Apostle, (examples of volunteers: Lectors, Ushers, Eucharistic Ministers, Children's Liturgy of the Word, K of C, Festival, Garage Sale, Fish Fry, etc.) and you haven't taken Protecting God's Children, you will need to register for this course. This course is offered in person OR if you're computer savvy, you can do it online in the comfort of your own home. You can register directly on the VIRTUS website at www.virtus.org for either in-person at an area church or take the course online.

If you HAVE taken Protecting God's Children **PRIOR to 2020**, you need recertification and that module is done online. If it's been a while since you logged in and you can't remember your login id or password, you will need to go on the VIRTUS website and choose "I need login help" then choose either "Password Reset" or "Username Recovery" and follow the steps. Once you have gained access, it will prompt you as to the training course that you will need. For those needing recertification you should be taking: "Protecting God's Children Awareness Session 4.0 Vulnerable Adults 2.0 Combined." Please note, this course is lengthy (approx. 90 minutes) but you can pause, save, and resume your position in the training if you cannot complete it in one sitting. Individuals in this category will receive certificates showing completion of the module. I understand that this seems like an inconvenience, but our goal is to insure that our young people have a safe haven in our parish. The more eyes and ears out there protecting them, the better. If you have any questions, you can contact me and I'll help walk you through the process.
