#### Thursday, September 30

Adult Choir-The adult choir is open to 9th grade studentsadults with a desire to sing and help lead the assembly in sung prayer. Rehearsals are Thursdays, 6:30-8:30pm, once a month on Saturdays at 3:00pm, and a half hour before liturgies scheduled.
