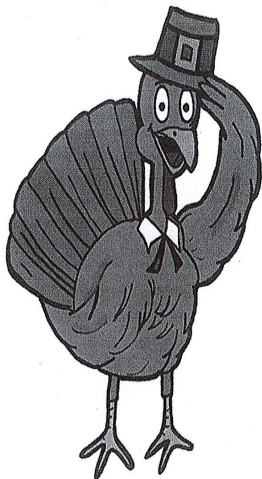


**Food

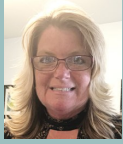

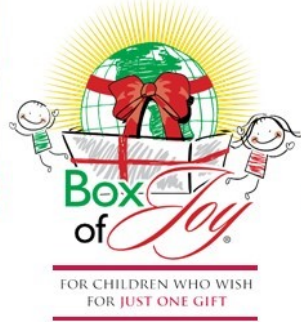

info flyer as well!! Thank you in advance!!

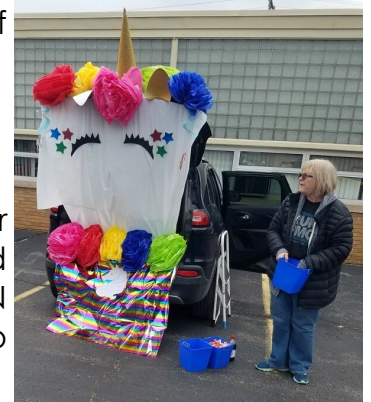
TRUNK OR TREAT
