

# THE HOLY FAMILY OF *Jesus, Mary & Joseph*



December 28, 2025

Sometimes the Lord demands great trust in us, requiring that we accept a fact of our lives without explanation or justification. So it was that when the Lord came to Joseph he came with an explanation that required great trust.



The question that Joseph asked was a delicate one: "How did my wife become pregnant?" Joseph knew Mary was with child but not how or why. He did not know what to do. There was no one to turn to for advice so he turned to God in prayer.

God responded in a dream. He told Joseph that the child was the result of divine action. Joseph was a man of great faith and accepted Jesus as the Son of God.

One thing he did know: he loved Mary deeply. He did not understand what was going on, but his love for her led him to trust her. It was a love and trust like that between any two human beings who truly love each other. They do not always understand what is going on or what will happen to them in the future, but they know that their love for each other and their faith in God will get them through.

Joseph was always a man of deep trust. At Christmas he finally did find a place for Jesus to be born. Then he took a long trip to save the baby from the envious and wicked King Herod. After living for several years as an alien in a foreign land, he returned with his family to Nazareth. There he supported Mary and Jesus by the skill and sweat of his carpentry. Joseph worked, loved his family and listened carefully for the will of God in the midst of the ordinary events of his daily life.

Joseph preaches a powerful sermon by his simple life. He was not God like his foster son. He was not "full of grace" like his wife. He was just an ordinary human being getting through a life he did not always understand. He lived a simple life loving deeply Mary and Jesus, believing that everything would work out for the best. He lived a life of love and trust and this got him through the many days of his life that had questions without answers.

It is a lesson that we should remember when we, like St. Joseph, face our own days without answers. St. Joseph is not only a great role model and a powerful intercessor for us during Advent but all year long.


