There are not many kids in Holliday Park. There are a handful, but most of our residents are well above 50. When I head south on one of my walks I can pass through a couple of subdivisions. I definitely see kids there.

I am quite taken away at the size of the houses they are growing up in. I grew up on Memorial on Detroit's west side. Our house initially had two bedrooms and one bathroom. The house took up maybe 750 square feet. Eventually my Dad converted the attic into a bedroom and built a second bathroom of sorts in the basement. The houses I routinely see are probably 2000 square feet with at least three bedrooms. Most have attached garages. We never had a garage on Memorial.

I have to wonder if the kids in those subdivisions will enjoy the same size house when they are adults, or if the cost of housing will be too high for most people to afford a house. I wish them the best but I'm not sure they will live out their expectations.
