May the Risen Lord be with us in the joys and sorrows of our lives. May we experience Easter each day of our lives until we attain the life that never ends.

My birthday came and went without a whole lot of fanfare, My son Mark and daughter-in-law Soojin took me to DeLuca's for supper. Later that evening Steve's household called and sang Happy Birthday. The next day, the 10th, I made the run up to Holy Sepulchre to visit Kathy's grave. It's hard to believe that she is dead eight years already.


