Last week we observed the feast of Epiphany. We have all experienced an epiphany. Our epiphany is a sudden understanding of something that up to now has eluded us. Sometimes it is profound like learning something about one of our ancestors, or coming to understand something that up to now we could not understand. Sometimes it is on the light side, like walking into a grocery store and finding one of our favorite foods on sale.

The gospel points to a number of people who experienced an Epiphany. The shepherds discover the baby wrapped in swaddling clothes and laying in a manger; the Magi discover the King of the Jews; Herod discovers that someone threatens his reign. What's interesting is that the lowest of society, the shepherds, and the highest of society, Herod, experience an epiphany.
