NEW BUSINESS

Water Maintenance

Due to the former maintenance personnel declining to provide operational knowledge or training on the water system, the Town is currently addressing ongoing issues without the benefit of historical or technical insight.

A contractor has inspected the electrical components of the system and confirmed that all electrical appears to be functioning properly. A valve was replaced during this process; however, no additional electrical deficiencies were identified.
