Diversity Grant

The annual Arizona Education Association Diversity Grant offers opportunities to develop and pursue instructional programs or curriculum that promote diversity, tolerance, and respect for humankind.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The recipient(s) must be an AEA member or team of AEA members
- One annual grant in an amount up to \$1,000 may be awarded for:
 - Developing and implementing a curriculum that promotes diversity in an educational setting;
 - Developing and implementing an instructional program that promotes a positive atmosphere, tolerance, respect, and global appreciation for all humankind; or,
 - Creatively utilizing a diversity curriculum to increase student achievement.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. No party may submit more than one nomination per year.
- 2. Applications shall be submitted on the AEA Diversity Grant application. Supplemental materials submitted with the application will not be returned.
- 3. Once a party has received the grant, it may not apply again for the same curriculum, program, or activity.
- 4. A grant may not be used for capital equipment purchases.
- 5. Applications may be submitted by any AEA member, local association, committee, or task force.
- 6. The AEA Board of Directors or their designee shall receive the applications and determine the grant recipient. The AEA Board of Directors may not select arecipient(s).
- 7. The grant recipient will receive the award at the annual AEA Foundation Salute to Excellence ceremony.
