

Human & Civil Rights Award

Do you know an individual who deserves recognition for their work in human and civil rights?

ELIGIBILITY:

Recognition may be given for leadership or involvement in:

- Association programs that promote ethnic minority participation with the association at the local or state level.
- Programs or activities that lead to improved human relations.
- Efforts that lead to improvement in school district support of human & civil rights.
- Successful implementation of human & civil rights in Arizona education.
- The quest for improved human relations and civil rights.

GUIDELINES:

1. The Award shall be an annual award.
2. No party may submit more than one nomination per year.
3. Nominations shall be submitted on a form provided by the AEA although supplemental, non-returnable materials may be submitted with the form.
4. Once a party has received the Award, the individual may not be nominated again for the same project or activity.
5. The recipient will receive an engraved plaque and a \$1,000 cash award.
6. The Board of Directors (or a designated committee or subcommittee) shall receive the nominations and recommend recipient(s) for the Award. The Board may recommend no recipients.
7. Nominations may be submitted by any AEA member, local association or committee.
8. Those eligible to be nominated may be:
 - a) any Arizona resident,
 - b) any past resident who worked in Arizona, and
 - c) if eligible for membership, an AEA member.
