

Nell Wilcoxen Future Educator Scholarship

For those pursuing a teaching career

GUIDELINES:

- Scholarships will be awarded at the Salute to Excellence ceremony. Scholarships will be awarded to AEA members or their immediate family members planning to pursue careers as educators.
- Those individuals eligible for this scholarship includes high school students beginning their college education and current school employees seeking to become teachers.
- The primary criteria used to select recipients will include academic abilities, honors, leadership positions, school activities, community activities, interest in teaching as a career, written expression, references and needs. Employment, extracurricular activities, and other responsibilities will be considered under the criterion of school and community activities.
- Scholarships awarded will be sent directly to the colleges and universities indicated by the recipients and deducted from their registration and tuition costs during the first year of enrollment. All applicants will be notified of the results in April.
- The deadline is March 1 for all parts of the Application. All information must be typed and name must be at the top of each page.
- The response to the Essay Question should not exceed 750 words.
- The Reference Form should be given to a personal reference or to someone familiar with your academic abilities (teacher, counselor, etc.). The forms can be returned to you and mailed in with your Application or they can be sent directly to AEA by the deadline. Indicate the names and addresses of the references on page 5 of the Application. Only two references will be accepted.
