Exams

My original plan was to hold exams in April/May but like most things, Covid has changed that! We have worked very hard on our set work in Ballet, Tap & Modern and I am still looking into holding a face to face exam session in all three genres in the summer term.

Exams are a great opportunity to show how students have progressed and can instil a great sense of achievement.

ISTD are highly regarded exams and require a lot of hard work, so we will only enter students if we feel that they are at the required level.

In our first week back, Miss Alison and I will be looking at the set work needed for the exams, and will make a decision about who would be ready. I would strongly encourage any student to take an exam, if we consider them ready.

I have put up tap syllabus videos on our Google drive and will put on some modern syllabus videos too, so please encourage students to have a look at these and practise during the Easter holidays.

New Classes

I am excited that we are adding some new classes to our timetable.

Strength & Stretch: Similar to body conditioning, a class to strengthen the muscles we need as dancers. Focussing in particular on the core and leg muscles, as well as safely stretching muscles to improve flexibility. This class is a great addition to all dance disciplines.

Jazz Technique: This class will improve strength, flexibility and conditioning of technique included in turns, leaps and kicks.

Theatre Jazz: A fun class where you will learn and perfect dances you would see on the stage and screen! Lyrical/Contemporary: This is an expressive form of dance. Lyrical & Contemporary uses fluid, continuous movements using elements of other styles of dance such as ballet, modern and jazz.

These new classes are all £4.50 each. If a student takes 4 or more classes in total across the whole timetable, the 4th and any additional classes from the <u>new class list will be reduced to £4.00 each.</u> Sibling discount will continue to be applied across all classes.

The new **Monday** classes will be held at **Tilehouse Street Baptist Church** in the downstairs main hall.

The new Thursday classes will be held at Lucas Lane Sports Club.

Spaces will be limited so please contact me if you would like to sign up! These classes will be starting at the beginning of next term, week commencing Monday 19th April.

Monday 19th April and Thursday 22nd April will be free trial days for all new classes, however you must let me know if you would like to attend.

Small Timetable Change

With us working on syllabus work, I need to slightly change our timetable for ballet classes. Grade 6 and Intermediate will be separate classes and will now include their pointe work in their own class. Primary ballet is a lovely big class (with a waiting list!) so I am having to split it into two with Grade 1 Ballet now being 45 minutes. I will e-mail all students this will affect.
