Entry Requirements

- A bachelor degree with a minimum average grade of B- or a GPA of 2.7 out of 4.3. For secondary/senior school teaching, at least 50% of credits achieved must in a subject related to what you want to teach.
- Secondary School diploma with minimum grade C, or an average of 60, for both English and Maths.
- Experience of working or volunteering with children is encouraged.
- Applicants who meet the above criteria will be invited to attend an online interview with course tutors.

Funding and Money Matters

The total cost of tuition for 2026-27 is £17,000.
