In this process, the taxpayer's tax return information may be sent to another location for one or more of the following reasons; interviewing the taxpayer, preparing the tax return, or performing a quality review. The taxpayer may come back to the intake site for the quality review or to review and sign the completed tax return.
- |X| C. Return Preparation and/or Quality Review Only Site: This site may receive returns from one or more intake sites to prepare and/or quality review returns. This site generally does not take walk-in or appointments from other taxpayers in their location.
- D. Combination Site: This site prepares returns for other permanent or temporary intake sites as well as assisting walk in and/or appointment only taxpayers within their location.
- E. 100% Virtual VITA/TCE Process: This method includes non face-to-face interactions with the taxpayer and any of the VITA/ TCE volunteers during the intake, interview, return preparation, quality review, and signing the tax return. The taxpayer will be explained the full process and is required to consent to step-by-step process used by the site. This includes the virtual procedures to send required documents (social security numbers, Form W-2 and other documents) through a secured file sharing system to a designated volunteer for review.

Part II: The Sites Process:

Explain how each process will be followed to assist taxpayers remotely. How will the site manage:

1. Scheduling the appointment

Taxpayers can call 424-374-8003 or visit www.TherightWayTaxServices.com. Taxpayers are told it may take up to a week to prepare their Tax Return and return it to them.

2. Securing Taxpayer Consent Agreement

Taxpayers sign the last page of IRS Form 14446 giving VITA permission to process their tax return remotely.

Taxpayers also sign the IRS Form 15080 VITA Global Carry Forward Consent which is page 4 of the IRS 13614 Intake Form. This permits their basic information to populate in future VITA Tax Returns whe they return next year to any VITA site.

3. Performing the Intake Process (secure all documents)

Wearing masks, face shields and latex gloves, the VITA Intake Volunteers greet Taxpayers when they arrive. All taxpayer documents will be placed in the White IRS Important Taxpayer Papers Envelope and then the envelope is stored in a metal locked container at the Virtual Drop-off Location for delivery to the VITA Tax Preparers.

4. Validating taxpayer's authentication (Reviewing photo identification & Social Security Cards/ITINS)

Taxpayers are instructed when they make an appointment to bring copies of all picture ID cards and all Social Security cards that pertain to people who will be on their tax return. VITA Virtual Intake Volunteers will confirm taxpayers identies when they drop off their tax documents.

5. Performing the interview with the taxpayer(s)

Taxpayers will arrive at their scheduled appointment with all their tax documents ready to be dropped off at the Virtual Intake Center. VITA Intake Volunteers will ensure that they have included the appropriate documents that VITA has requested. The tax return will be delivered to the Tax Preparer who will call the Taxpayer and conduct the 13614 Intake Interview by phone.

6. Preparing the tax return

The White IRS Important Tax Papers Envelope with the taxpayer's documents will delivered to the VITA Volunteer who is certified at the Basic level. Wearing a N95 mask and latex gloves, the Tax Preparer will use the 13614 to input the taxpayer's information into the TaxSlayer software.

7. Performing the quality review

A different VITA certified at the Advanced level will perform the Quality Review of the tax return on Tax Slayer software. The Tax Return will be printed and 8879s for the federal return and state returns will be printed. All documents that VITA does not need to retain will returned to the taxpayer by putting them in the White IRS Important Taxpayer Papers Envelope.

8. Sharing the completed return

Documents that VITA needs to retain will be collected in a Blue Folder. The Taxpayer will be called when their tax return is ready to be picked up. Taxpayers will be told to return to the VITA Virtual Intake/Delivery Center during it's operating hours. Taxpayers who are filing Joint Returns will be reminded that both spouses need to be present to sign the 8879s and to receive their tax return.

9. Signing the return

Wearing masks, face shields, and latex gloves, the VITA Tax Return Delivery Volunteers will greet the Taxpayer upon arrival, check their picture IDs, locate their White IRS Important Tax Papers Envelope, pull out the 8879s and have both Taxpayers sign the 8879s. The 8879s are retained in a Blue Folder for the VITA E-Filer to confirm permission to e-File.

10. E-filing the tax return

The Blue Folder with their 13614 Intake Form, their signed 8879s, copies of their Picture ID and Social Securty cards, copies of W-2 and 1099s, and their signed 14446 will be delivered to the VITA Tax Return E-Filer. The 13614 along with the VITA required documents will be stored at United Way for 3 years in accordance with VITA requirements.
