

Make your Offer

Accepted Offer.

Have a real estate attorney to review contracts and for closing. Make an appointment with a home inspector. (see Vendors List)

Know your inspection deadline.

Visit the town building department, are there any Orders of Notice, have any required permits been pulled for this property?

Visit the local police department to ask about the neighborhood. Any registered offenders? Call your insurance agent. Check insurance costs. Check Flood Zone.

Apply for a mortgage.

Know your Mortgage contingency deadline.

Review any contingencies on Mortgage Commitment with your agent and your lender.

Purchase insurance and get a binder to provide to your lender.
