- 9. Patio and Outdoor Areas:** Clean outdoor furniture, sweep patios, and prepare the garden for spring planting.

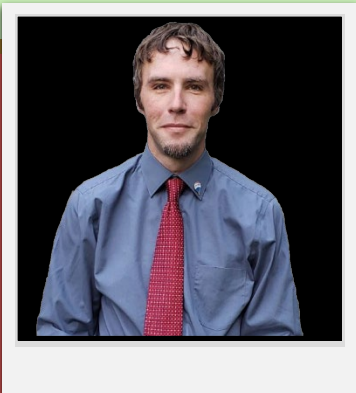




Springing Towards Sold: Why Selling Your Home in Springtime Is a Winning Move
