WHY THIS PLAYER SHOULD BE ON YOUR RADAR

Pierre profiles as a high-energy, coachable box-to-box/defensive midfielder who consistently scans, finds pockets, offers passing lanes and connects play with simple one- and two-touch actions. **He adds value through effort, competitiveness and intelligent movement**, including late arrivals into the box. In the observed match he scored the opener by continuing his forward run and reacting first to a rebound. **His combination of baseline technique, work rate, defensive willingness and coachability** makes him a low-risk player to monitor or acquire for a club that needs midfield energy and reliability.

OBSERVATIONS — STRENGTHS AND OPPORTUNITIES

Observed vs Orlando City B, August 11, 2026 — 61 minutes analyzed. Deployed primarily as a right-sided defensive midfielder with licence to support both phases and arrive late into the box.

- Frequent shoulder checks and strong spatial awareness; actively seeks pockets and passing lanes
- Good first touch and composure under pressure; willing line-breaking and progressive passing
- Strong hustle, competitiveness and defensive shape; communicates with teammates
- Supports both phases and makes useful late entries into the box; highly coachable
- Must get tighter to opponents as they receive so they cannot turn or start counters
- Improve 1v1 defensive shape rather than diving in
- Sprint back with greater urgency in transition
- Aerial impact can improve
- Passing execution can be cleaner even when the decision is correct

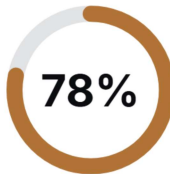
