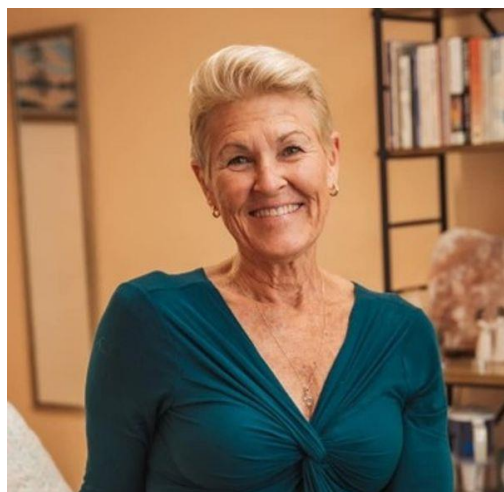


ANITA PEEK SMITH, ΦΜ
