Dr. Susan Mullane, a 3-time UM alumna, received her Ph.D. in Higher Education/Sport Administration from the University of Miami, and also holds her Master's and Bachelor's degrees from UM. A former student-athlete, All-American diver, and one of the first women in the country to receive an athletic scholarship, Dr. Mullane served the University of Miami as Associate Dean of Students for 10 years. Dr. Mullane has extensive experience in leadership and student development. As a faculty member in the School of Education and Human Development's Department of Kinesiology and Sport Sciences, Dr. Mullane was an original founder of the Undergraduate Sport Administration program that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Education and its program director for over 15 years. Dr. Mullane teaches both undergraduate and graduate courses (online and on campus) in Sport Administration. She chairs the SEHD Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.

Dr. Mullane's areas of expertise and research include leadership, ethics, and sport ethics, and higher education. She has published and presented extensively in these areas, and her publications appear in such journals as the *Sport Marketing Quarterly*, *Journal of Sport Management*, the *International Journal of Sport Communication*, *Applied Research in Coaching and Athletics Annual*, and the *NASPA*(Student Affairs Administration) *Journal* and she has made over 50 presentations at local, national, and international conferences and professional meetings. She was a founding member of the University of Miami's Ethics Consortium and has served as the co-director of the Program for Ethics and Social Responsibility in the School of Education and Human Development. Dr. Mullane also served as Chairperson of the Ethics Advisory Committee for the School Board of Miami-Dade County Public Schools, in addition to co-authoring the Code of Ethics adopted by the Miami-Dade County School Board. Most recently, she developed and now directs the Sport Ethics Debate programs in the School of Education and Human Development. The Sport Administration graduate student Sport Ethics Debate recently completed its 14th year.

Dr. Mullane has served on the University of Miami Alumni Association as a director and as its faculty representative.

As an undergraduate at UM, Dr. Mullane joined Kappa Kappa Gamma and served as treasurer and president. She is also a past president of the Miami Women's Panhellenic Association.
