Birding

Medicine River Wildlife Centre - Distance from Cabin: 40 minutes east on highway 54 toward Innisfail (you can make this part of your trip in or out from the cabin).

“MRWC is a wildlife hospital and education centre. We provide care for injured, orphaned, and compromised wildlife with the aim of returning them to appropriate wild habitats.”

They are located on a beautiful slough that has three nesting pairs of Sandhill Cranes.

- Cranes typically arrive around April 10
- Eggs hatch around June 2
- Hunting lessons begin in the slough in early August.

This is a must see for all nature lovers.

There is a short interpretive walk that is just so good for your soul.

Raven Brood Trout Station - Distance from Cabin: 30 minutes, south on Hwy 22 towards Sundre

- Birdwatching
 - Short hike
 - Fish hatchery
 - Disc Golf
 - Beautiful scenery
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Phyllis Lake - Distance from Cabin: 14 minutes east on Hwy 591.

Get out on your kayak/paddleboard/canoe and enjoy the sights and sounds of so many birds. Last year we watched an osprey, bald eagle, herons, loons and more!
