January 11, 2026, The Baptism of Our Lord Reflection on the Lord's Prayer – Introduction (2)

On this Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord, let us continue our reflection on the origin and importance of the Lord's Prayer. **The origin of the Lord's Prayer**—the Our Father—is found in the Gospels of Saints Matthew (6:9–13) and Luke (11:1–4). Both agree that Jesus taught this prayer at the request of His apostles. They saw Him praying and desired to pray as He did. Therefore, they said, “Lord, teach us to pray.”

By teaching this profound prayer, Jesus entrusted to His followers not only a formula of prayer, but also the right and proper way to address God, the right things to ask for, and the proper order in which to ask them — always according to God's will and not our own. For this reason, *the Lord's Prayer is the foundation of all formal prayers.* In essence, it contains the whole of Sacred Scripture — the Law, the Prophets, and the Psalms. Matthew's version includes seven petitions, whereas Luke presents five.

The Lord's Prayer (*Oratio Dominica*) is **the most perfect and most important of all prayers** for several reasons: 1. **The Lord Himself is its author.** He composed it, taught it, and desires everyone to pray it with proper devotion. St. Tertullian calls it “the summary of the whole Gospel.” 2. **It is a Trinitarian prayer.** It is addressed to the Father; the Son Himself prays it on our behalf and in union with the human heart, expressing our deepest desires to the Father; and the Holy Spirit enables us to cry out, “Abba! Father!” and praying with us with inexpressible groanings. 3. **The Apostles prayed it** and integrated it into the divine liturgy. The early Church prayed the Lord's Prayer three times a day (Didache 8:3), in place of the “Eighteen Benedictions” prayed by every pious Jew. 4. **The Church concludes the Liturgy of the Hours** with the recitation of the Lord's Prayer. 5. **It is a filial prayer.** Not only does God's Son pray on behalf of us—His adopted sons and daughters—but the Holy Spirit fills our hearts with filial love and prays within us according to the will of God. 6. **It is most pleasing to the Father.** 7. **It is a profound gift of the Father to humanity** through His Son and the Holy Spirit. 8. **It reveals an eschatological character**, as its petitions are filled with hope and love. 9. **It is prayed during the Communion Rite** of the Eucharistic liturgy.

St. Thomas Aquinas teaches that the Lord's Prayer holds the principal place among all prayers. First, because it was taught by Our Lord Himself; and second, because it possesses five essential qualities necessary for prayer. Prayer must be: a) confident, b) directed toward what is right, c) well ordered, d) devout, and e) humble. Therefore, the Lord's Prayer must be prayed devoutly and reverently, with the awareness that Christ, the Holy Spirit, and the entire Church are praying everywhere whenever we recite it individually.



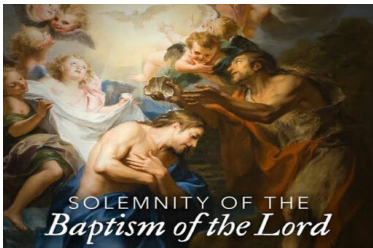


