Reflection on the Lord's Prayer: "Our Father" (3)

Calling God "Our Father": A Privilege or a Gift?

Calling God "Our Father"—is it a privilege or a gift? The simple answer is that it is not merely a privilege, but a gift. God himself gives this gift to humanity through his Son, Jesus Christ, our Savior. The image of God as "Father" is not a human invention or the result of a rational search for God's name and identity. Rather, it is revealed by Jesus himself. As he says, "No one knows the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him." (Matt 11:27) Although humanity was given a privileged relationship with God in the beginning, this privilege was lost through the sin of pride, greed, and disobedience of Adam and Eve. As a result, the "privilege of being in paradise—the Father's house—was lost."

The Jewish people did not dare to call God "their Father." God's fatherhood is revealed to humanity only through Jesus. Only in and through Jesus do we receive the privilege—and the daring hope—to invoke God as "Our Father." This privilege is primarily a gift from God, given to us through the merits of the sacrificial death and resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches this beautifully: "Thus, the Lord's Prayer reveals us to ourselves at the same time that it reveals the Father to us. O man, you did not dare to raise your face to heaven; you lowered your eyes to the earth, and suddenly you have received the grace of Christ—all your sins have been forgiven. From being a wicked servant you have become a good son. ... Then raise your eyes to the Father who has begotten you through Baptism, to the Father who has redeemed you through his Son, and say: 'Our Father.' ... But do not claim any privilege. He is the Father in a special way only of Christ, but he is the common Father of us all, because while he has begotten only Christ, he has created us. Then also say by his grace, 'Our Father,' so that you may merit being his son." (CCC 2783)

When we invoke God as "Our Father," we regain our dignity, happiness, and identity as sons and daughters of God. By saying "Our Father," we enter into a new and personal relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Not even the angelic orders address God as their Father. Only human beings who are redeemed by Christ's death and resurrection and incorporated through Baptism are given this privilege. When we say "Our Father," we express our solidarity and communion with one another and become one family.

Although all human beings can call God "Father" in a general sense, because they are created by him in his image and likeness, only baptized persons, in a particular and sacramental sense, can rightfully and with filial dignity call God "Our Father." Therefore, invoking God as "Father" is not simply a privilege or a duty. Rather, it is a special gift and a right granted to those who are baptized in the water and blood of Christ. Through Baptism, our sins are forgiven, we are restored to our original dignity and holiness, we become adopted sons and daughters of God, and we receive the inheritance of eternal life. Baptismal grace gives us the daring hope to address God as "Our Father" and "Abba."

Do you Need Sacraments?
For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes.
DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.

Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism.

Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

Faith Formation for Children

Parents are the primary teachers of faith. They have serious obligations before God to train their children in faith and in the love of God. Please, register your children for "Faith Formation" or "Sunday School". We also need volunteers to teach or to be an aid in the classrooms. If you love teaching children, and watch them grow in our amazing faith, please do not hesitate to sign up to be a teacher or aid.

 Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia, llene los formularios necesarios, haga una cita con el sacerdote y tome las clases de preparación sacramental. **NO FIJE UNA FECHA** para ninguna celebración sin antes consultar con el sacerdote y haber tomado las clases necesarias para los Sacramentos.

Bautismos: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia **al menos tres meses antes** de fijar la fecha del Bautismo. Las **clases pre-bautismales son obligatorias** para los padres y padrinos. Se debe presentar el **acta de nacimiento del niño(a)**.

Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote **al menos seis meses antes** de fijar la fecha de su boda. Las **clases de preparación matrimonial son obligatorias**. Los **formularios de matrimonio** deben ser entregados a la parroquia.

Si necesita una **anulación** de un matrimonio previo, por favor comuníquese con el sacerdote o con un diácono.

Para **ambos sacramentos**, debe ser miembro de nuestra parroquia y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a **otra parroquia** y desea recibir los Sacramentos en la nuestra, deberá presentar **una carta de su sacerdote**.

Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser **católicos en regla**, es decir, practicar su fe y estar **casados por la Iglesia** ante un sacerdote o diácono (si aplica). Si pertenecen a otra parroquia, deben traer **una carta de su sacerdote**.

Formación en la Fe para Niños

Los padres son los primeros maestros de la fe. Tienen una seria responsabilidad ante Dios de educar a sus hijos en la fe y en el amor a Dios. Por favor, inscriban a sus hijos en el programa de "Formación en la Fe" o "Catecismo Dominical". También necesitamos voluntarios que deseen enseñar o apoyar en los salones de clase. Si te gusta enseñar a los niños y ver cómo crecen en una fe maravillosa, no dudes en inscribirte como maestro o asistente. 




Daughters of Mary Ministry
