March 8, 2026, The Third Sunday in Lent
Reflection on the Lord's Prayer: "Hallowed Be Your Name"

"Hallowed be thy name" is the next petition in the Lord's Prayer. Let us understand the meaning of the words **"hallowed"** and **"name."** First, the word *hallowed* is derived from the Greek *hagiozo* and the Hebrew *qadosh*; it means to sanctify, consecrate, or set something apart as holy. The Catechism presents three distinct meanings of the word *hallowed*. It says: "The term 'to hallow' is to be understood here not primarily in its **causative sense** (only God hallows, makes holy), but above all in an **evaluative sense**: to recognize as holy, to treat in a holy way. And so, in adoration, this invocation is sometimes understood as praise and thanksgiving. But this petition is taught to us by Jesus as an **optative**: a petition, a desire, and an expectation in which God and man are involved. Beginning with this first petition to our Father, we are immersed in the innermost mystery of his Godhead and the drama of the salvation of our humanity. Asking the Father that his name be made holy draws us into his plan of loving kindness for the fullness of time, 'according to his purpose which he set forth in Christ,' that we might 'be holy and blameless before him in love.'" (CCC #2807)

The holiness of God is the inaccessible center of his eternal mystery (CCC 2809). Hence, God chose to reveal *his holiness* in the created world and in human beings, whom he created in his image and likeness. The holiness and beauty found in creation and humanity are called the "glory and majesty of God." However, when this original holiness was lost in the created world, due to the sin of Adam and Eve, God decided to restore his holiness, beauty, glory, and majesty through his Son's suffering, death, and resurrection.

God's plan for restoring holiness begins with the call of Abraham and the promises he made to Abraham and his descendants. From the time of Moses, God not only reveals **his holiness** (Exodus 3:5) but also **his name**: "I AM WHO AM." Later, on Mount Sinai, God instructs Moses to consecrate the people. He gives the Ten Commandments, in which they are instructed to keep the Lord's name and the Sabbath day holy. Again, in Leviticus 19:2, God commands the people to be holy as he is holy: "You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy."

A careful reading of the Pentateuch shows how God gradually reveals **his holiness** and **his name** to the chosen people. He commands them to honor and glorify his name and holiness by observing the commandments, the liturgical laws of sanctity, and the moral laws of purity. Therefore, when we pray this petition, **"Hallowed be your name,"** first of all we acknowledge him as the only true God, who is the source of all creation. Second, we recognize his holiness, his majesty, his immortal and eternal nature, and all of his divine qualities, such as love, mercy, justice, and goodness. Third, we pray together with Jesus for our sanctification, redemption, and protection from the powers of evil. Finally, we ask God to restore his holiness and glory in us so that we may be reconciled with him and "be holy as our heavenly Father is holy."

Please Be Mindful of Respectful Dress Code For Divine Worship

Please remember that our liturgical dress code does NOT allow shorts, T-shirts, shirts with messages which are inappropriate to wear in the church, short skirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, crop tops, sleeveless tops (no bare shoulders or revealed midriff). Do you Need Sacraments?
For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.

Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.

 Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, llame a la oficina de la iglesia, llene los formularios necesarios y haga una cita con el sacerdote. Bautizos: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia **al menos tres meses antes** de fijar la fecha del Bautismo. Se requieren **clases prebautismales** para los padres y los padrinos/madrinas. Debe presentar el **acta de nacimiento del niño(a).**

Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote **al menos seis meses antes** de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren **clases de preparación matrimonial.** Los **formularios de matrimonio** deben entregarse a la parroquia.

Para **ambos sacramentos**, usted debe ser **miembro de nuestra parroquia** y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser **católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia.** Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar **casados por la Iglesia** por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

Si necesita **una anulación de su matrimonio anterior**, por favor comuníquese con el sacerdote o con un diácono.

 Parents are the primary teachers of faith. They have serious obligations before God to train their children in faith and in the love of God. 


