Why Cover the Images During Lent?

Why Cover the Images During Lent?
 Isn't the last two weeks of Lent among the most important and spiritually profound times of the liturgical year to meditate on the Passion of Christ? Why, then, do we cover the crucifix and sacred images during this time? The practice of veiling sacred images during Lent traces back to regions of Germany, where a custom developed of completely covering the altar with a cloth throughout the Lenten season. This cloth, known as the "Hunger Cloth," kept the altar hidden until Holy Week. It was then removed during the proclamation of the Gospel recounting that *the veil of the temple was torn in two* (cf. Gospel of Luke 23:45). This covering served a practical purpose—visibly marking the season of Lent—but it also carried deep symbolic meaning. It expressed communal penance and a sense of being set apart from the full joy of the Lord's table. Over time, the practice expanded to include other sacred images and gradually evolved from covering them for the entire Lenten season to just the final week or two.

Today, the Catholic Church preserves this tradition. The Roman Missal instructs: "In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from the Fifth Sunday of Lent may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil."

There are several profound reasons for this practice: *First*, veiled images immediately draw our attention, reminding us that this is a sacred and solemn time. *Second*, the purple veils stir a spirit of penance within us. *Third*, the hidden images awaken hope, pointing us toward the moment when the veils will be lifted and the beauty of Christ and His Church will once again be revealed. *Finally*, although these last weeks of Lent are marked by sorrow as we recall Christ's Passion, they also invite us to live in joyful expectation of the Resurrection.

The words of Saint Paul the Apostle help illuminate this mystery: "At present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face. At present I know partially; then I shall know fully, as I am fully known" (1 Cor 13:12).

Let us make good use of this sacred time of Christ's Passion to deepen our personal relationship with God.





Do you Need Sacraments?
For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.

Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.

Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote **al menos seis meses antes** de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren **clases de preparación matrimonial.** Los **formularios de matrimonio** deben entregarse a la parroquia.

Para **ambos sacramentos**, usted debe ser **miembro de nuestra parroquia** y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser **católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia.** Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar **casados por la Iglesia** por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

Si necesita **una anulación de su matrimonio anterior**, por favor comuníquese con el sacerdote o con un diácono.




