**May 10, 2026, The Sixth Fifth Sunday of Easter — Reflection on the Lord's Prayer: "Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespassed against us." (1)**  
 The fifth petition of the Lord's Prayer consists of two parts. In the first part, we pray, "Forgive us our trespasses," and in the second, "as we forgive those who trespass against us." Let us first consider the significance of this petition. One might wonder why Jesus included this petition in the Lord's Prayer. Some believers ask: "Were our sins not washed away when we professed our faith and were baptized in the name of the Most Holy Trinity? Did Jesus not justify us 'once-for-all,' forgiving our past, present, and future sins through His death on the cross? Is there truly a need to confess our sins repeatedly?" To address these questions, we must understand the purpose of this petition and clarify the nature of sin. Let us examine the first part of this petition and consider four points why prayer for forgiveness is essential.  
**First,** St. John Chrysostom says, "This petition for forgiveness belongs specifically to believers. Because the uninitiated (the unbaptized) cannot truly call God "Father." We discover forgiveness within the nurturing pedagogy of the Church. If this prayer is intended for believers, it is clear that the "profit of repentance" remains necessary even after baptism. If Jesus had not intended for us to seek ongoing mercy, He would not have instructed us to pray for it."  
**Second,** St. Cyprian reminds us that this petition serves as a daily reminder of our fallen nature. We pray for forgiveness daily because we sin daily. This echoes the words of St. John the Apostle: "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, the Lord is faithful and just to forgive us our sins" (1 John 1:8-9).  
**Third:** To understand the purpose of this petition, we must distinguish between justification and sanctification. By Justification, Christ saved all of humanity and creation once-for-all through His death and resurrection. Those who deny the need for daily forgiveness often cite Colossians 2:13-14, which states that "when we were dead in our sins, God forgave us all our trespasses, erasing the record that stood against us with its legal demands." Though we are already justified, we still need sanctification. Because we still commit sins in our daily lives. Just as we require "daily bread" for physical sustenance, we require "daily forgiveness" for our sanctification, purification, and the cleansing of our hearts and souls. Jesus, knowing our hearts are easily polluted by worldly acts, taught us to seek daily mercy just as we seek daily bread.  
**Finally,** this petition reminds us of God's abounding mercy and His infinite desire to forgive us. He calls us to "be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." To reach this state of holiness, we need ongoing sanctification. Although we are justified by divine grace, we must participate in our daily sanctification through the intentional effort of loving God and our neighbor. This petition helps us to trust in the divine mercy and goodness, and to return to the Father's house like the prodigal son and the repentant thief.

**Do you Need Sacraments?**  
**For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.**

**Baptisms:** Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

**Marriage:** Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

**Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors:** Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

**If you need Annulment** for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.
