**June 7, 2026, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**  
**Reflection on the Lord's Prayer: "Lead us not into temptation." (2)**

We continue our reflection on the petition: "Lead us not into temptation". Last week, we reflected on the meaning of the word, "temptation" and distinction between "trials, test and temptation". Now, let us consider three major sources of temptations. This is necessary in order to identify the true origin of temptation and to overcome them by the grace of God.

First, the **devil is explicitly called "the tempter"** (Matt 4:3), for he tempted Adam and Eve in the garden (Gen 3:1). The devil tempted Jesus in the wilderness (Matt 4:1). Jesus clearly teaches that the devil is the murderer from the beginning and the father of lies (John 8:44). If the devil tempted Jesus, the Son of God, then he certainly has the power to tempt us. Like Jesus, St. Peter also warns Christians to remain vigilant, saying: "Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour" (1Pt 5:8). Though the devil is the primary cause of temptation, not all temptations directly come from him. He has other agents that cause temptations.

Second, temptation arises from within **our own fallen human nature and personal desires**. St. James says, "Each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. Then desire, when it is conceived, gives birth to sin, and sin, when it is fully grown, brings forth death" (James 1:14-15). St. John the Apostle identifies **three kinds of disordered desires**: the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life. These do not come from the Father but from the world (1 John 2:16). St. Paul likewise teaches that when people persist in following the disordered passions of their hearts, they fall into deeper sin (Romans 1:24). So, one must identify one's habitual sins which are difficult to overcome by one's own efforts. So, frequent confession and certain penances must be made to avoid such sins.

Third, Sacred Scripture also points to **"the world"** as a source of temptation. Although the world and all that is in it were created by God, the fallen world—separated from God, shaped by secular ideologies, and marked by corrupt systems—can become a source of temptation, spiritual decay, and sin. At times, even **other people** can become occasions of sin. Thus, Jesus says in Matthew 18:7: "Woe to the world for temptations to sin! For it is necessary that temptations come, but woe to the man by whom the temptation comes!" We, Christians are called not only to overcome our own temptations, but also to never become the cause of temptation to others.

Therefore, the petition "lead us not into temptation" should be understood more deeply. Some translate it as "let us not fall into temptation." God is never the cause of temptation, which is the work of the devil. However, God permits us to be tempted—by the devil, by our own desires, and by the world—for our spiritual growth and benefit. Let us pray earnestly and ask God to keep us from the powers of evil. In our next reflection, let us consider the spiritual fruits that can arise from temptations and trials. — Fr. Jesu

### 5 datos sobre la Fiesta del Corpus Christi

- La Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, o Corpus Christi, celebra la Presencia Real de Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía—**Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad.**
- Hubo 2 milagros separados que llevaron a la institución de la fiesta en la Iglesia Católica: una visión a Santa Juliana de Mont Cornillon y el milagro de Bolsena.
  - \* La visión de Santa Juliana: La santa tuvo una visión de la Iglesia bajo la apariencia de una luna llena que tenía una mancha oscura. Durante la visión, escuchó una voz misteriosa y celestial que le explicó que la luna representaba a la Iglesia en ese momento, y la mancha oscura simbolizaba el hecho de que faltaba una gran fiesta en honor al Santísimo Sacramento en el calendario litúrgico.
  - \* El Milagro de Bolsena: En 1263, un sacerdote se había vuelto tibio en su amor por la Eucaristía y comenzó a dudar de la verdadera presencia de Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento. En respuesta a su duda, cuando recitó la oración de consagración mientras celebraba el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa, sangre comenzó a brotar de la hostia consagrada y a derramarse sobre el altar y el corporal.
- El festival fue instituido en toda la Iglesia por el Papa Urbano IV en 1264. Antes de eso no había ningún festival universal para conmemorar el sacramento de la Eucaristía.
- Inspirado por Santa Juliana y el Milagro de Bolsena, el Papa Urbano IV encargó a Santo Tomás de Aquino la composición de la Misa y el Oficio para la fiesta de Corpus Christi. Es decir, Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Panis Angelicus y O Salutaris Hostia.
- Uno de los aspectos litúrgicos clave de Corpus Christi es su procesión. Estas permiten a los cristianos dar testimonio público de su fe, dar gloria a Dios, y simbolizan nuestra peregrinación terrenal hacia la Jerusalén celestial. Las procesiones eucarísticas comenzaron poco después de la institución de la Fiesta de Corpus Christi.

**5 Facts about the Feast of Corpus Christi**

1. The Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist—**Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.**
2. There were 2 separate miracles that lead to the institution of the feast in the Catholic Church: A Vision to St. Juliana of Mont Cornillon and The Miracle at Bolsena.
  - \* **St. Juliana's Vision:** The saint had a vision of the Church under the appearance of a full moon which had one dark spot. During the vision, she heard a mysterious, heavenly voice explain that the moon represented the Church at that time, and the dark spot symbolized the fact that a great feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament was missing from the liturgical calendar.
  - \* **The Miracle at Bolsena:** In 1263 a priest had grown lukewarm for his love of the Eucharist and began to doubt Jesus' true presence in the Blessed Sacrament. In response to his doubt, when he recited the prayer of consecration as he celebrated the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, blood started seeping from the consecrated host and onto the altar and corporal.
3. The festival was instituted throughout the Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. Before that there had been no universal festival to mark the sacrament of the Eucharist.
4. Inspired by the St. Juliana and The Miracle at Bolsena, Pope Urban IV commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the Mass and Office for the feast of Corpus Christi. Namely, Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Panis Angelicus, and O Salutaris Hostia.
5. One of the key liturgical facets of Corpus Christi is its procession. They enable Christians to give public witness to their faith, give glory to God, and they symbolize our earthly pilgrimage to the heavenly Jerusalem. Eucharistic processions began shortly after the institution of the Feast of Corpus Christi.

**Do you Need Sacraments?**  
**For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.**

**Baptisms:** Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

**Marriage:** Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

**Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors:** Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

**If you need Annulment** for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.

**¿Necesita Sacramentos?**

**Matrimonio:** Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote **al menos seis meses antes** de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren **clases de preparación matrimonial**. Los **formularios de matrimonio** deben entregarse a la parroquia.

Para **ambos sacramentos**, usted debe ser **miembro de nuestra parroquia** y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer **una carta de su sacerdote**.

**Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores:** Deben ser **católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia**. Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar **casados por la Iglesia** por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer **una carta de su sacerdote**.

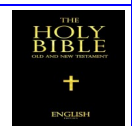
