**June 28, 2026, Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
**Reflection on the Lord's Prayer: Concluding Notes.**

Dear friends, we come to our final comments on the theme of prayer. A few quotes from the saints may help us emphasize the profound necessity, importance, power, and benefits of prayer.

First, "Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God" (*St. John Damascene*). "Prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven. It is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy" (*St. Thérèse of Lisieux*). In the liturgy of the Mass, there is a beautiful moment when the priest invites us, saying, "Lift up your hearts," and everyone responds, "We lift them up to the Lord." Then he says, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God," and all respond, "It is right and just." **Thus, prayer involves the raising of our minds, hearts, and voices to the Lord.**

Second, "Prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for him" (CCC 2560). **Prayer is about the covenantal relationship between God and His people.** "If a man wants to be always in God's company, he must pray regularly and read regularly" (*St. Isidore, Bishop*). "Prayer is nothing else but union with God" (*St. John Vianney*).

Third, **prayer is both an ambassador and a weapon.** "Prayer is the best weapon we have; it is the key to God's heart. You must speak to Jesus not only with your lips but with your heart. In fact, on some occasions, you should speak to Him only with your heart" (*St. Padre Pio*). "Prayer stands before God as an honored ambassador. It gives joy to the spirit and peace to the heart" (*St. John Chrysostom*).

Finally, next to the Liturgy of the Mass, the Liturgy of the Hours, and Eucharistic Adoration, we have two of the simplest yet most profound prayers. They are powerful and encompass the entire history of our salvation: **the Lord's Prayer and the Hail Mary.** Therefore, when we pray the Rosary, through the Blessed Virgin Mary, we enter into the mystery of our salvation.

The words of *St. John Paul II* are worth mentioning here: "The Rosary is my favorite prayer. A marvelous prayer! Marvelous in its simplicity and its depth. In the prayer we repeat many times the words that the Virgin Mary heard from the Archangel, and from her kinswoman Elizabeth. ... The Rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christ-centered prayer. It has all the depth of the gospel message in its entirety. It is an echo of the prayer of Mary, her perennial Magnificat for the work of the redemptive Incarnation which began in her virginal womb. ... So, to pray the Rosary is to hand over our burdens to the merciful hearts of Christ and His Mother."

**Therefore, if we take the Rosary as our weapon and pray it daily, Mary, our Mother, will not only defend us from the powers of evil, but she will also lead us to her Son, the Holy Spirit, and the Father in heaven.** — Fr. Jesu

**Do you Need Sacraments?**  
**For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, and make an appointment with the priest, take Sacramental preparation classes. DO NOT SET A DATE for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments.**

**Baptisms:** Please contact the church office at least three months prior to setting a date of Baptism. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child's birth certificate.

**Marriage:** Please contact the church office to visit with your priest at least six months prior to setting a date of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish.

For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.

**Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors:** Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest.

**If you need Annulment** for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.

**¿Necesita Sacramentos?**

**Bautizos:** Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia **al menos tres meses antes** de fijar la fecha del Bautismo. Se requieren **clases prebautismales** para los padres y los padrinos/madrinas. Debe presentar el **acta de nacimiento del niño(a).**

**Matrimonio:** Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote **al menos seis meses antes** de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren **clases de preparación matrimonial.** Los **formularios de matrimonio** deben entregarse a la parroquia.

Para **ambos sacramentos**, usted debe ser **miembro de nuestra parroquia** y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

**Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores:** Deben ser **católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia.** Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar **casados por la Iglesia** por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer **una carta de su sacerdote.**

Si necesita **una anulación de su matrimonio anterior**, por favor comuníquese con el sacerdote o con un diácono.

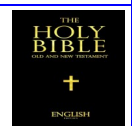
