July 20, 2025, Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Forms of Prayer (5) – Prayer of Petition and Intercession
Is there a distinction between the prayer of petition and intercession? Yes. St. Thomas Aquinas distinguishes between **prayer of petition and intercession** by focusing on the object and the recipient of the prayer. **Petition** is a prayer for one's own needs or desires, while **intercession** is a prayer for the needs of others. Both are forms of prayer that involve asking God for something, but they differ in the focus of the request. Most often our prayers take the form of petition, because we ask God for good health, wealth, forgiveness, protection, happiness, and personal wellbeing. The Bible gives us some examples of prayers of petition. Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemani for the removal of the cup of suffering from him (Matt 26:36-46), and the prayer of persistent widow (Luke 18:1-8). The **prayer of intercession focuses on the wellbeing of others. Intercessory prayer** has a mediatory function. **"It is a mysterious battle"** (CCC 2577) in which the intercessor appeals to God for the needs of others. Both prayer of petition and intercession **express dependence on God's providence and grace, and require the spirit of humility.** The patriarchs, prophets, kings of the Old Testament drew their strength for their mission of intercession for the people and nation. At times, their prayer was argument, or a complaint with God for their people, but their prayers always waited for divine intervention for redemption, mercy, forgiveness, and providence of God. **The Scripture points out that there are several intercessors before God: the primary intercessor is Christ himself.** He interceded for his disciples, for the dead, and for the healing of so many people, and above all the last seven words of Jesus from the cross are powerful intercessory prayers. Second, the Holy Spirit also intercedes for us with "inexpressible groanings" (Rom 8:26-27). Third, the Blessed Mary, the Mother of God also constantly prays for the Church. Fourth, the Church, the body of Christ unites herself with Christ, her head offers her sacrifices, sufferings, prayers, and works and intercedes for all humanity, this happens particularly in the liturgy of the Church (CCC 1361 & 1368). Fifth, we have angels who are appointed by God to guard, govern, care, and present our intercessions before God also pray for us (CCC 336). Sixth, we have saints who also intercede for our needs. Therefore, it is essential to have devotions to our favorite saints. Finally, we are called to intercede for one another, Jesus wants us to pray not only for our friends and family but above all for our enemies and those who persecute us. **Prayer of intercession could be noble, mysterious, and a hidden ministry which is known to God alone. So why don't you consider becoming a part of a prayer group to intercede for others.** — Fr. Jesu.
