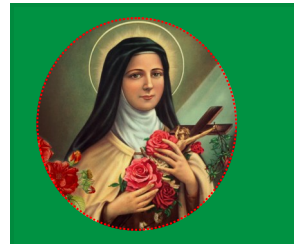

Sunday: 7:00 & 9:00 am (Eng.) 11:30 a.m. (Spanish) Holy Days of Obligation 12 Noon / 6:00 p.m.	Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time (Jeremiah 20:7-9; Romans 12:1-2; Matthew 16:21-27)  Today's readings focus on the theme of discipleship and transformation in Christ. In the first reading, we read Jeremiah's cry to God for help. Jeremiah was the youngest of all the Old Testament prophets. His life timeline shows that God called him at the age of 17 to be a prophet. He was a prophet during the most difficult times in the history of Israel. His ministry extended for about 40 years (626 – 584 BC) during the reign of five kings of Judah: Josiah, Jehoahaz, Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin, and Zedekiah. He also witnessed the destruction of the Temple built by Solomon (957 BC). This reading reminds us of the deepest moments of distress and suffering we endure for the sake of our faith. We can also draw strength from this reading that we should never abandon God or his gospel no matter how difficult the life might be. In the second reading, St. Paul urges us to offer our bodies as a living sacrifice to God, and not to conform ourselves to the demands of this present age, but to be transformed in Christ by renewing of our minds and discerning the will of God. <u>In what ways do we conform ourselves to the demands of this present age?</u> We conform ourselves to this world, for example, when we choose to support abortion, illegal immigration, human trafficking, advanced technologies which undermine the human dignity and moral values, or the political leaders, private enterprises, and the proponents of evil and injustice at all levels. Christ's disciples are strongly urged to follow Christ's way and not the way of the world. In the gospel reading, Jesus strongly condemns Peter and tells him, get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human being do. Christ's disciples must think with Christ and think as Christ thinks. Christian discipleship demands that we go with Christ and carry our daily cross and endure the suffering that comes on account of preaching the gospel of love, justice, peace. Your faith is essential to transform this world! So, don't abandon it! — Fr. Jesu

Do you Need Sacraments? For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, make an appointment with the priest, and take Sacramental preparation classes. <u>DO NOT SET A DATE</u> for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments. Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least <u>three months prior to setting a date of Baptism</u>. Pre– Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child’s birth certificate. Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest <u>at least six months prior to setting a date</u> of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish. For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. <u>If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.</u> Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest. If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.	¿Necesita Sacramentos? Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, llame a la oficina de la iglesia, llene los formularios necesarios y haga una cita con el sacerdote. También deberá tomar las clases de preparación sacramental. NO FIJE UNA FECHA para una celebración sin antes consultar con el sacerdote y haber tomado las clases necesarias para los sacramentos. Bautizos: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia al menos tres meses antes de fijar la fecha del Bautismo. Se requieren clases prebautismales para los padres y los padrinos/madrinas. Debe presentar el acta de nacimiento del niño(a). Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote al menos seis meses antes de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren clases de preparación matrimonial. Los formularios de matrimonio deben entregarse a la parroquia. Para ambos sacramentos, usted debe ser miembro de nuestra parroquia y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer una carta de su sacerdote. Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia. Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar casados por la Iglesia por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer una carta de su sacerdote. Si necesita una anulación de su matrimonio anterior, por favor comuníquese con el sacerdote o con un diácono.

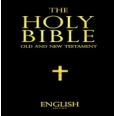


The Little Flower Choir Ministry
