Observations for the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Cycle A
(Ezekiel 33:7-9; Psalm 95; Romans 13:8-10; Matthew 18:15-20)

Corrie Ten Boom survived the Nazi concentration camps in World War II and she gave the credit to God for strengthening her through her faith in Jesus. But she faced a serious challenge to her faith when, after sharing her story of survival with a particular audience, she was approached by an older German man who confessed to her that he had been one of the guards at the camp where she had been imprisoned.

He shared that after the war he had become a Christian, and he asked for her forgiveness. Corrie says she realized that she did not have within herself the strength to say anything, but she knew what she must do. Offering a brief prayer to Jesus for help, she simply placed her hand in the outstretched hand of the former guard. She described what happened next;

“The current started in my shoulder, raced down my arm, sprang into our joined hands. And then this healing warmth seemed to flood my whole being, bringing tears to my eyes. ‘I forgive you, brother!’ I cried. ‘With all my heart!’” (Guideposts, © 1972)

Reconciliation is an essential skill for those who follow Jesus. The strength to go to a brother or sister in private to resolve some difference or difficulty, even an offense, comes from God, from the grace that He lavishes on us through Jesus Christ. When we cooperate with this grace, to follow the footsteps of Jesus, we grow in virtue, that spiritual strength that makes possible what once seemed impossible.

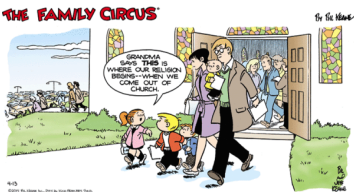

Do you Need Sacraments? For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, make an appointment with the priest, and take Sacramental preparation classes. <u>DO NOT SET A DATE</u> for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments. Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least <u>three months prior to setting a date of Baptism</u>. Pre– Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child’s birth certificate. Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest <u>at least six months prior to setting a date</u> of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish. For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. <u>If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.</u> Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest. If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.	¿Necesita Sacramentos? Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, llame a la oficina de la iglesia, llene los formularios necesarios y haga una cita con el sacerdote. Para ambos sacramentos, usted debe ser miembro de nuestra parroquia y completar las clases requeridas. Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia. Please, register your children for “Faith Formation” or “Sunday School”. We also need volunteers to teach or to be an aid in the classrooms. 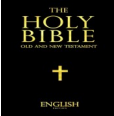
