August 10, 2025, Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Grades of Prayer (1)

Over the past few weeks, we have reflected on the various **forms** of prayer, such as adoration, praise, thanksgiving, petition, intercession etc. These forms express the different ways we relate to God and respond to His presence in our lives. In the weeks ahead, let us turn our attention to the different **grades** of prayer. Unlike St. Teresa of Avila, St. Thomas Aquinas does not provide a systematic classification of these grades. However, St. Pius X affirmed that the stages of prayer outlined by St. Teresa represent a progressive ascent toward Christian perfection. She emphasizes that the depth of one's prayer life corresponds closely to the depth of one's charity. According to St. Teresa's teaching, there are nine distinct grades of prayer: 1. Vocal Prayer, 2. Meditation, 3. Affective Prayer, 4. Prayer of Simplicity, 5. Infused Contemplation, 6. Prayer of Quiet, 7. Prayer of Union, 8. Prayer of Conforming Union, 9. Prayer of Transforming Union. The first four grades belong to what is traditionally called **the ascetical stage**, where human effort, spiritual discipline, and cooperation with grace are key. The remaining five are considered **mystical or infused prayer**, where the soul receives a more passive and grace-filled experience of God's presence. This mystical phase is marked by a growing interior stillness and a loving surrender to God's action in the soul. **We begin with the first grade: vocal prayer.** The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (2700–2706) teaches that vocal prayer is the most basic and foundational form of prayer. It involves expressing our thoughts and petitions through spoken or silent words, allowing our voices to articulate what our hearts and minds wish to offer to God. Vocal prayer can be spontaneous or structured, personal or communal. Examples include traditional prayers like the Our Father, Hail Mary, and the prayers of the Mass. These prayers are not merely recitations of words; rather, when prayed with devotion and attentiveness, they become powerful expressions of faith and love. St. Thomas Aquinas offers three reasons why vocal prayer is fitting and beneficial: 1. It helps stir interior devotion. 2. It allows us to honor God not only with our minds and hearts but also with our bodies. 3. It gives voice to the spiritual movements within the soul during prayer. When offered attentively and devoutly, vocal prayer can become a gateway to deeper forms of prayer, such as meditation and affective prayer, and serves as an initial step toward true contemplative union with God.
