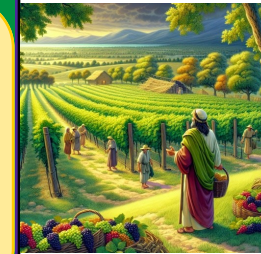

In the Catechism we read, "Envy is sadness at the sight of another's goods and the immoderate desire to have them for oneself. It is a capital sin. The baptized person combats envy through good-will, humility, and abandonment to the providence of God." (CCC 2553-2554). How different that evening in the vineyard could have been, how rich and rewarding the fellowship of the workers could have become, if those who started first could have forsaken their wicked thoughts and turned to the Owner (the Lord) for mercy, to ask Him to teach them His higher ways, His way of generosity, mercy and grace. If only they could have recognized in the late-comers the same value they had by responding to the Owner's invitation to work in His vineyard; if only they could have celebrated when they saw the late-comers being paid the same wage they received. Of course, in the parable, they did not. But we have the opportunity today, to forsake envy, to practice generosity and charity, and to conduct ourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ. ***** En el Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús nos advierte, mediante una parábola del Reino, sobre el peligro de la envidia. En el Catecismo leemos: «La envidia es la tristeza experimentada ante el bien del prójimo y el deseo desordenado de apropiárselo. Es un pecado capital. El bautizado combate la envidia mediante la caridad, la humildad y el abandono en la providencia de Dios.» (CIC 2553-2554). ¡Qué diferente habría sido aquella tarde en la viña, y qué rica y gratificante habría resultado la comunión entre los trabajadores, si aquellos que comenzaron primero hubieran dejado de lado sus malos pensamientos y acudido al Dueño (el Señor) en busca de misericordia, para pedirle que les enseñara sus caminos más elevados: su camino de generosidad, misericordia y gracia! Si tan solo hubieran reconocido en los que llegaron tarde el mismo valor que ellos tenían al responder a la invitación del Dueño de trabajar en su viña; si tan solo hubieran celebrado al ver que a los recién llegados se les pagaba el mismo salario que ellos habían recibido. Por supuesto, en la parábola no lo hicieron. Pero nosotros tenemos hoy la oportunidad de abandonar la envidia, de practicar la generosidad y la caridad, y de llevar una vida digna del Evangelio de Cristo.

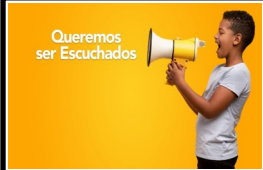

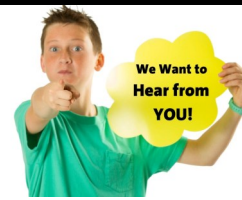

Do you Need Sacraments? For all your Sacramental needs call the church office, fill out necessary forms, make an appointment with the priest, and take Sacramental preparation classes. <u>DO NOT SET A DATE</u> for a celebration without consulting the priest, and taking necessary classes for the Sacraments. Baptisms: Please contact the church office at least <u>three months prior to setting a date of Baptism</u>. Pre– Baptismal classes are required for the parents and godparents/sponsors. Submit the child’s birth certificate. Marriage: Please contact the church office to visit with your priest <u>at least six months prior to setting a date</u> of your Wedding. Marriage prep classes are required. Marriage Forms need to be submitted to the parish. For both of these sacraments you must be a member of our Parish and must complete the classes required. <u>If you belong to another Parish and are seeking the Sacraments in our parish, you must bring a letter from your priest.</u> Requirements for Godparents / Sponsors: Must be a Catholic in good standing. That means, practicing your faith, married in the Church by priest or deacon. If you come from other parish bring a letter from your priest. If you need Annulment for your previous marriage, please contact the priest or a deacon.	¿Necesita Sacramentos? Para todas sus necesidades sacramentales, llame a la oficina de la iglesia, llene los formularios necesarios y haga una cita con el sacerdote. Debe presentar el acta de nacimiento del niño(a). Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina de la iglesia para reunirse con el sacerdote al menos seis meses antes de fijar la fecha de su boda. Se requieren clases de preparación matrimonial. Los formularios de matrimonio deben entregarse a la parroquia. Para ambos sacramentos, usted debe ser miembro de nuestra parroquia y completar las clases requeridas. Si pertenece a otra parroquia y desea recibir los sacramentos en nuestra parroquia, debe traer una carta de su sacerdote. Requisitos para Padrinos / Patrocinadores: Deben ser católicos en buen estado con la Iglesia. Esto significa practicar su fe y, si están casados, estar casados por la Iglesia por un sacerdote o diácono. Si vienen de otra parroquia, deben traer una carta de su sacerdote. 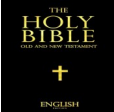
